Dear Keats Judging by the tone of your voice I would say that neither of your balls have dropped. By the way why would you bother talking to Wal. Nobody else does.

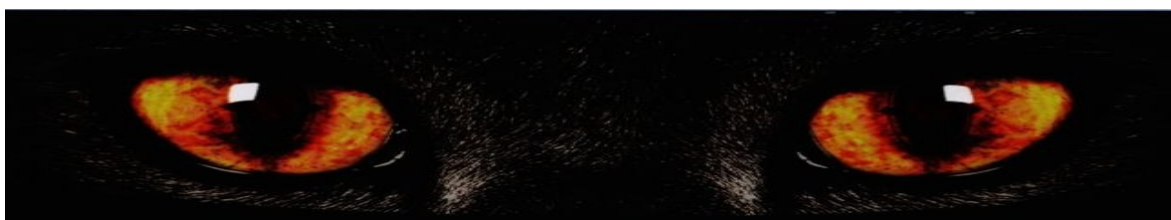
